Introduction

1. Section 83 of Reference A deals with the unauthorised use, possession or supply of emblems or flags and defines the powers of the Minister in relation to this issue. An important element of Section 83 is its intention to prevent individuals or organisations implying any official connection with the Defence Force, or elements thereof, when no such official connection exists.

Aim

2. The aim of this instruction is to detail the policy and procedures governing the authorisation and use of RAEME emblems.

RAEME Emblems

3. The authorized RAEME emblems are defined as:
- a. The RAEME Badge as detailed in Corps Instruction Number 5
 - b. The RAEME Corps Flag as detailed in Corps Instruction Number 9
 - c. The RAEME Cipher as detailed in Corps Instruction Number 6.

Authorisation for Use

4. In accordance with the provisions of the Defence Act 1903, the Minister for Defence has authorised in an Instrument of Appointment dated 28 Jun 1999, the Head of Corps to grant written authority for a person to make, supply or offer to supply, an approved emblem of that Corps, or an emblem so nearly resembling an approved emblem of that Corps, or an emblem so nearly resembling an approved emblem of that Corps as to be capable of being mistaken for such an emblem. This includes authorisation to use or wear such an emblem

5. The use, making, wearing or supplying of an approved emblem of the Corps, without the written permission of the Head of Corps is forbidden.

Request for Authorisation to Use, Make, Wear or Supply an Approved Emblem

6. Requests from individuals or organizations to use, wear, make or supply an approved RAEME emblem are to be submitted in writing to the Head of Corps.
